Simple, hands-on control.

Move the aluminum operating rail to position the fabric. An internal spring mechanism holds it where you need it. The tensioned design suits compatible tilt-and-turn windows and glazed doors.

For heights over 4 times the width, consult MHZ before ordering.

FLEXIBLE MOUNTING

Glazing bead: straight, sloped or front mounting.
Window sash: angle brackets.
Drill-free: MHZ adhesive set attaches directly to the glass.
